

Plywood Cup 2016



On Saturday, June 25, Easter Seals Nova Scotia and The Atlantic Division of CanoeKayak Canada will be partnering for the Plywood Cup 2016. Easter Seals Nova Scotia helps thousands of Nova Scotians with disabilities annually. Proceeds will go to support both organizations.

The event will take place on beautiful Lake Banook. Participants sign up in teams and each team receives a limited amount of building materials: 2 sheets of plywood, a hammer, hand saw, nails, pencil, yard stick, tape measure and duct tape. Teams have ninety minutes to build their boat. One member from each team will then navigate their boat around a course on the lake. Additional building materials can be earned through fundraising. The more pledge donations that you get, the more additional building materials you will receive. There will be prizes awarded for the top fundraising team, top individual fundraiser, the Plywood Cup race winning team, and the Titanic award for the first boat to sink.

The Plywood Cup is a fun, family oriented event that is unique, challenging and rewarding for all those involved. If you would like to register a team, or would like to donate you can visit the Plywood Cup 2016 website. A link is also available in the regatta schedule on the ADCKC website.



Athlete Highlights

Mark de Jonge took first place at the Canadian Olympic Team Trials in Gainesville, Georgia, securing the RIO2016 spot. He qualified by winning the 2015 200m K1 World Championships.

Genny Orton of Lake Echo, teamed with Ontario's KC Fraser, qualified a RIO2016 quota sport for Canada by winning the Americas continental qualifier in K2. They will attempt to earn the

Canadian entry at the National Team trials in Montreal, coming up in late June.
